

## HOW-TO GUIDE FOR RESEARCH POSTERS

The JAHC Poster Session is a dynamic forum for professionals, students, and the public to share their knowledge, ideas, and / or work with others. Possible topics include research, provings, case presentations, new clinical ideas, organizational work, educational work, topical reviews or student projects. The JAHC poster session is designed to be interactive and fun, as well as informative. Don't be intimidated by your impression of what research posters are "meant" to be! We want to see your great ideas, your clinical pearls, your student projects.

Poster session presenters will create a poster to display at JAHC 2024. They should be available to discuss their material, answer questions and converse with the attendees, who view the posters in a relaxed, social setting at the JAHC conference. Poster presenters must be present at JAHC to participate.

### FAQs:

- Research posters are an engaging, visual way to tell an audience about your research.
- Posters should be able to stand on their own, considered a snapshot of your work intended to engage colleagues in a dialog about the work done.
- Posters will be presented to conference attendees during a live session at JAHC and will remain displayed throughout the conference for viewing by attendees, guests, and vendors.
- An easel to display your poster will be provided.

### Applicants will be asked to submit:

- Title of presentation
- Presenter(s)/Co-authors (include bio and headshot for all presenters.
- Disclosure: Please disclose the Funding Source for the research and any potential Conflicts of Interest, including all industry relationships
- Type: Research, Proving, Case Presentation, Topical Review, New Clinical Idea, Presentation of Organizational or Educational Work, Student Project
- Summary: No more than 400 words summarizing the research's Objective(s), Design, Measure(s), Result(s), Conclusion(s)

**PLEASE NOTE:** Poster session presenters must be registered attendees of the 2024 Joint American Homeopathic Conference. Poster session presenters are not given free admission to the conference. Poster Session Presenters are responsible for developing their poster and transporting it to the conference.
